

Problem Description

Increased parental stress, decreased baby bonding, and delayed language acquisition are significant concerns associated with NICU admissions. Language acquisition in the infant, which can be enhanced with parental reading, can also enhance parents' sense of control, intimacy, and normalcy in an otherwise frightening experience for parents. Neonatal reading programs have been shown to be beneficial to the infants, decrease parental stress, and promote parent-infant bonding.

PICOT Question:

In neonatal intensive care unit babies and their parents (P), will establishing a reading program (I), as compared to current practice with no reading program (C), decrease stress for parents and promote bonding between parents and babies(O) over the time of one year (T)?

Setting

- ✤ 84 bed Level III NICU
- Average daily census of 59
- Around 8000 deliveries/year
- ✤ 1456 NICU admissions (FY 2018)
- ✤ 190 infants less than 32 weeks gestational age admitted to NICU (FY2018)
