Cavilon: Apply every 3 days OR when the patient receives a bath:

On admission apply Cavilon No Sting Barrier. Reapply every 3 days and/or when baby receives a bath.

Let Cavilon dry for 60 seconds (make sure it is not tacky). This will create a barrier to protect the skin.

The skin may still look red under the Cavilon while it is healing, and the barrier remains in place.

If bleeding occurs or the rash is getting worse, please take a picture, put into medical record, and start using Desitin and contact Wound Care

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cleanse with sensitive wipes and apply Cavilon No Sting Barrier q 3 days 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For redness, non-yeast rash and intact skin, cleanse with sensitive wipes and apply Cavilon No Sting Barrier q 3 days. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For <u>bleeding</u> and redness, cleanse with water wipes and apply Desitin cream with every diaper change. Please upload a picture into medical record before applying Desitin and contact Wound Care. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For erythematous, denuded (moist), non-yeast rash, cleanse with water wipes, apply light dusting of stomahesive, spray with cavilon barrier spray to "crust" powder and apply Desitin into diaper every diaper change 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For erythematous, with yeast rash (bumps), intact skin, cleanse with water wipes and apply Cavilon No Sting Barrier q 3 days 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For erythematous, denuded (moist), with yeast (bumps) rash, cleanse with water wipes and apply Cavilon No Sting Barrier q 3 days.
